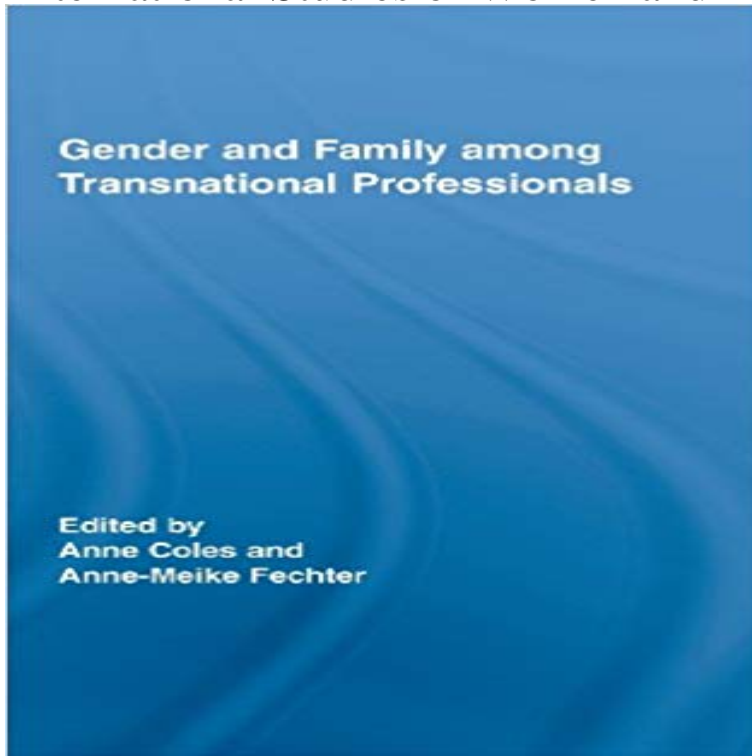


Gender and Family Among Transnational Professionals (Routledge International Studies of Women and Place)
