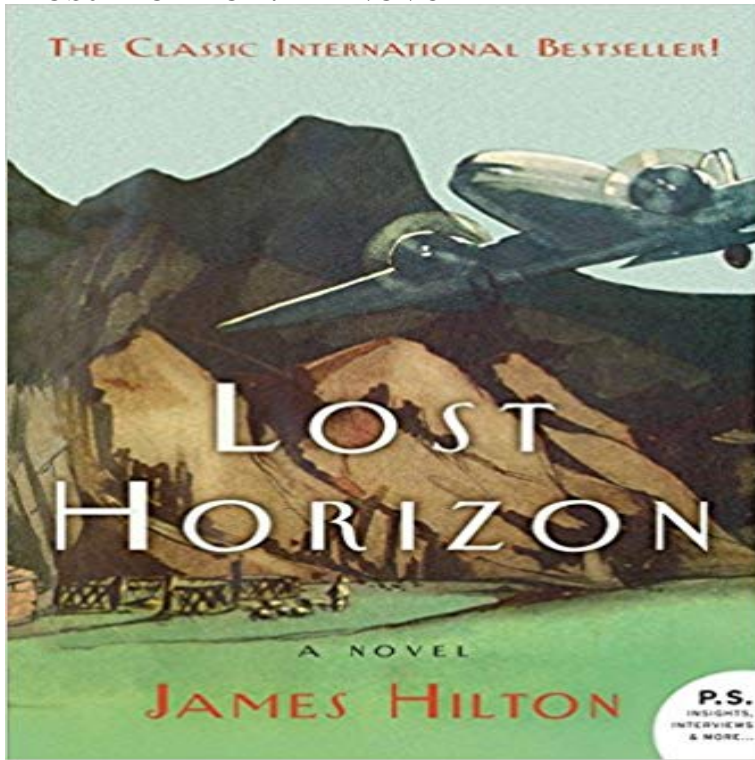


Lost Horizon: A Novel
