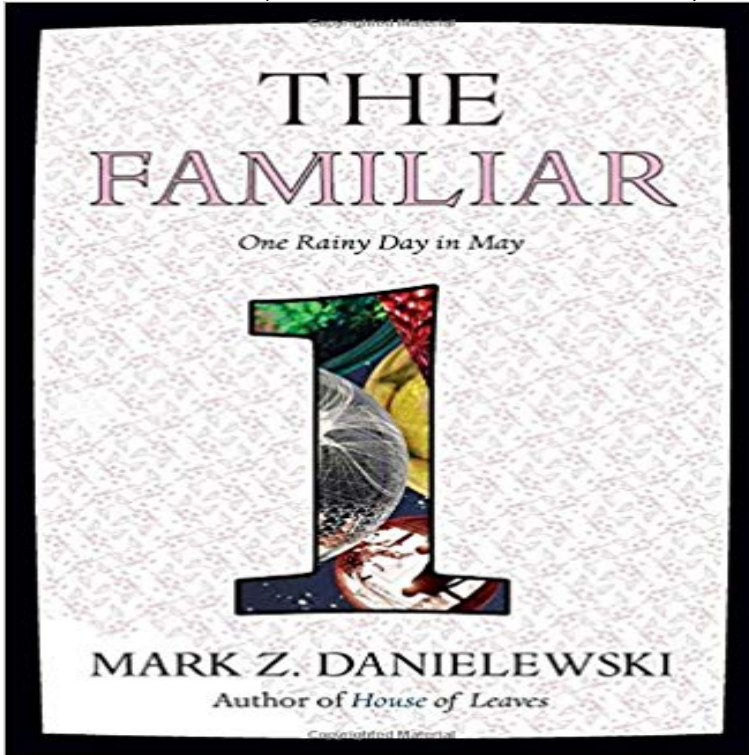


The Familiar, Volume 1: One Rainy Day in May
