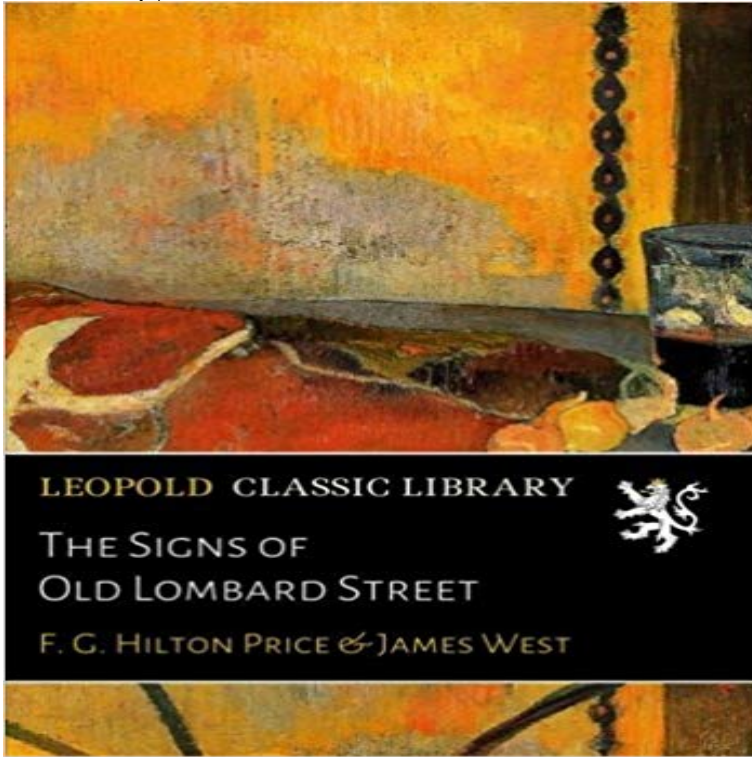


The Signs of Old Lombard Street
