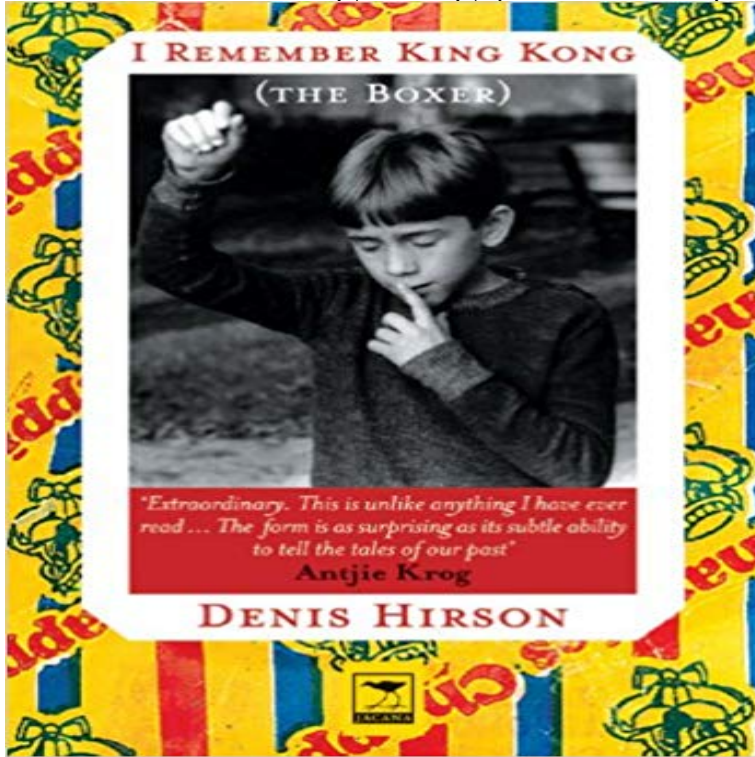


I Remember King Kong (The Boxer)
